

HISTORIC HOUSE IN CHILMARK

We are offering a historic, circa 1760 Cape Cod house with an addition to anyone interested in moving it from its current location at 49 North Road, Chilmark. The Chilmark Historical Commission has determined the house to be a Historically Significant Structure and a Preferable Preserved Structure. The building is seemingly beyond repair. If the building is not moved from the site by December 30, 2007 it will be demolished. Any interested party may make an appointment to view the house with Mollie Doyle or Thomas Bena at 508-560-1332. The structure must be disassembled and/or moved from the site in its entirety by a licensed and bonded contractor or house mover.
