

MEMO ABOUT HARIPH'S CREEK DOCK AND ARMY CORPS PERMIT

RE: Permitting for the Hariph's Creek Dock

Dear Gentlemen:

Some weeks ago when we applied for, and received, ConCom permission to make emergency repairs and perform maintenance on the Hariph's Creek Dock and floats, Chuck pointed out that there is no permit for that installation.

I got Ginny to do some research and although we can find open permits for other projects and docks (mainly in the harbor) it does seem certain that the Hariph's Creek Dock lacks a permit, and this has been confirmed by ~~Tim~~. One of the conditions of the emergency permit is that the Town apply for that Army Corps permit.

I asked Ginny to talk to Vineyard Land Surveying about the process to follow. Reid Silva advised her that it is the Executive Secretary, acting for the Town, who should complete the application (since it is a Town obligation). We have the drawings from Kent Healy for the installation and some other information although it may be necessary for VLS to do some professional drawings as well.

We would be glad to assist where possible.
