Re: Request for inclusion on the Warrant of our request to fund \$30,000 for planning and architecture services and \$10,000 for an Owners Project Manager

Your Public Safety Building Site Committee has been hard at work since its creation. We have had a number of meetings during which we analyzed from where the demand for services has emanated and made very preliminary estimates of space requirements.

In keeping with the title of our committee we have included planning for a Police Department module that could, but need not, be included in the design.

Our preliminary observations lead us to the tentative conclusion that somewhere in the area of the Town Center is the right place in which to locate the proposed facility. In order to proceed further the committee has determined that it requires the services of professional planning and architecture.

Pursuant to Massachusetts Public Construction law we are required to have an OPM on board before hiring a planner/architect.

Consequently the committee pursuant to motion duly passed, has asked me to communicate our request for inclusion on the Warrant for the next Town Meeting a request for \$30,000 for planning and architecture and an additional \$10,000 for the required Owner's Project Manager.
