

### Shellfish Regulations

Commercial Bay Scallop limit at two bushels a day until further notice  
Nashaquitsa Pond is open to dredging

The town encourages the transporting of small bay scallops from Quitsa to an area in Menemsha Pond south of the closed area off Burton's Camp, under the direction of the Shellfish Constable.

Area off "Burton's Camp" in Menemsha Pond is CLOSED to shell fishing for use as a seed sanctuary. Area shall have the corners marked by buoys placed by the Shellfish Constable.

No scalloping before 7:00 AM

No scalloping unless temperature is above 30° before 10:00 AM as shown on the official town thermometer at Menemsha Texaco.

No teeth on scallop drags to protect the Eel Grass.

No lead roller sweeps on scallop drags to protect the Eel Grass.

Pan dredges with chain sweeps are allowed.

Remind all fishermen to not uproot the Eel Grass.

Do not open Oyster season at this time.

The Shellfish Advisory Committee shall reassess the commercial limit, dredge regulations & the oyster season at their November 14<sup>th</sup> meeting and make their recommendations to the Board of Selectmen at their November 25<sup>th</sup> meeting.
